Based on information supplieds and assuming your operations will be as stated in your application for recognition of exemptions we have determined you are exempt from federal income tax under section tol(a) of the Internat Revenue Code as an organization described in section 501(c)(3).

We have further determined that you are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Coder because you are an organization described in section 509(a)(3).

If your nources of supports or your purposes, characters or method of operation change, please let us know so we can consider the effect of the change on your exempt status and foundation status. In the case of an agendment to your organizational document or bylans, please send us a copy of the amended document or bylans. Alsos you should inform us of all changes in your name or audress.

As of January 1, 1984, you are liable for taxes under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes) on remuneration of \$100 or more you pay to each of your employees during a catendar year. You are not liable for the tex imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA).

Since you are not a private foundation, you are not subject to the excise taxes under Chapter 42 of the Code. Howevers it you are involved in an excess benefit transaction, that transaction might be subject to the excise taxes of section 4958. Additionally you are not automatically exempt from other rederal excise taxes. If you have any questions about excises amployments or other federal taxes: please contact your key district office.

Grantors and contributors may rely on this determination unless the Internal Revenue Service publishes notice to the contrary. Howevers if you lose your section 509(a)(3) status, a grantor or contributor may not rely on this determination if he or she was in part responsible for or was aware of, the act or failure to act, or the substantial or material change on the part of the organization that resulted in your loss of such status, or it he or she acquired knowledge that the Internal Revenue Service had given notice that. you would no longer be classified as a section 509(a) (3) organization.

Donors may deduct contributions to you as provided in section 170 of the tode. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to you or for your use are deductible for federal estate and gift fox purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of Code sections 2055; 2105; and 2522.

Contribution deductions are ellowable to donors only to the extent that their contributions are gifts; with no consideration received. Ticket purchases and similar payments in conjunction with fundralsing events may not necessarily qualify as deductible contributions; depending on the circumstances. See Revenus Ruling 67-246, published in Cumulative Bulletin 1767-2, on page 104, which nets forth guidelines regarding the deductibility; as charitable contributions; of payments made by taypayers for admission to or other participation in fundralsing activities for charity.

In the heading of this letter we have indicated whether you must file form 990, Return of Organization Exempt From Income Tax. If Yes is indicated, you are required to file form 990 only if your gross receipts each year are normally more than \$25:000. However, if you receive a form 990 package in the mails please file the return even if you do not exceed the gross receipts test. If you are not required to file, simply attach the label provided, check the how in the heading to indicate that your annual gross receipts are normally \$25,000 or less, and sign the return.

If a return is required, it must be flied by the 15th day of the fifth month after the end of your annual accounting period. A penalty of \$20 a day is charged when a return is filed later unless there is reasonable cause for the delay. However, the maximum penalty charged cannot exceed \$10,000 or 5 percent of your gross receipts for the year, whichever is less. For organizations with gross receipts exceeding \$1,000,000 in any year, the penalty is \$100 per day per return, unless there is reasonable cause for the delay. The maximum penalty for an organization with gross receipts exceeding \$1,000,000 whall not exceed \$50,000. This penalty may also be charged if a return is not complete, so be sure your return in complete before you file it.

You are required to make your annual return available for public inspection for three years after the return is due. You are also required to make available a copy of your exemption application, any supporting documents, and this exemption letter. Failure to make these documents available for public inspection may subject you to a penalty of \$20 per day for each day there is a failure to comply (up to a maximum of \$10.000 in the case of an annual return).

You are not required to file tederal income tax returns unless you are subject to the tax on unrelated business income under section 511 of the Code. If you are subject to this tax; you must file an income tax return on form 990-T. Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Return. In this letter we are not determining whether any of your present or proposed activities are unrelated trade or business as defined in section 513 of the Code.
